

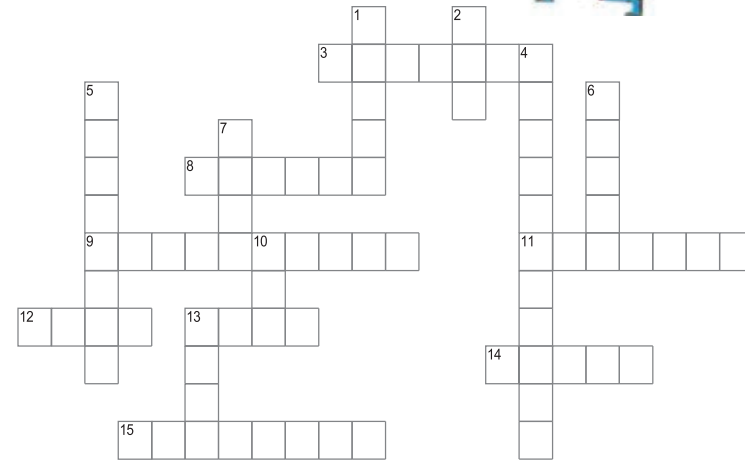

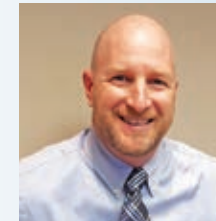

### The Truth about Cow Tipping

Cow tipping has been immortalized in several movies from the 1980s, and stories about students going cow tipping after parties are legendary at some universities. But there are no photos or videos of people tipping over cows to be found. The basic premise is that cows sleep soundly standing up. Dairy farmers and ranchers know that cow tipping is an urban legend or tall tale, kept alive by people who don’t know much about rural life.

- A cow can weigh between 1400 to 4000 pounds. Everyone knows they are large, but until you’re a few inches from them, it might be hard to picture just how enormous. Imagine tipping a station wagon
- Cows have excellent smell and hearing and are very wary of strangers coming upon them
- Cows can move quickly when needed and don’t hesitate to moo loudly to alert the herd when someone is approaching
- Cows have a good balance. Four legs, a low center of gravity, and hooves designed for muddy fields are better at staying upright than a person in tennis shoes
- Cows sleep lying down. So, a standing cow is an awake cow that can smell and hear you coming, regardless of how stealthy you think you are being
