

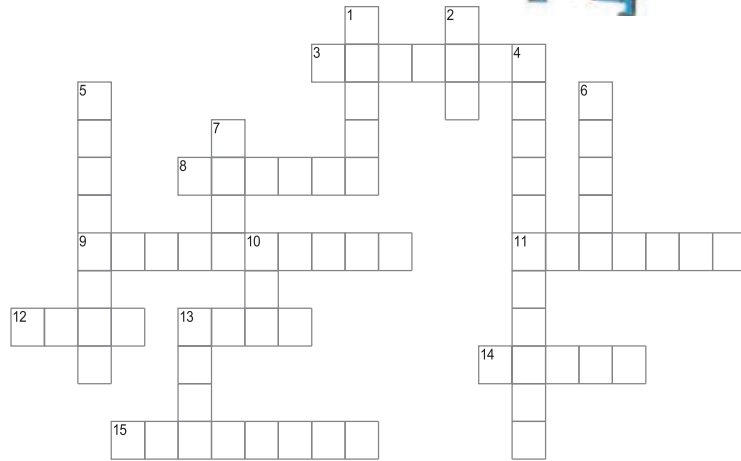

## Message from the President of Columbia Cottage



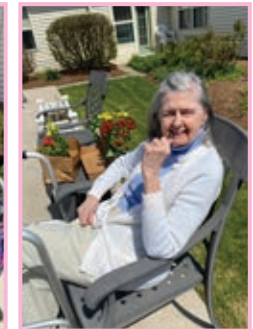
### Play for a Day

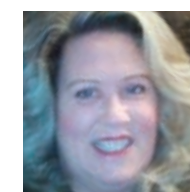

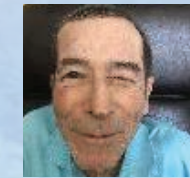
